

Job Aid: Paint Calculations and Paint Options

Introduction CCC® Estimating uses the Paint information you add on the **Vehicle Options** tab to make it's Two-tone or Three-stage paint calculations.

It is best practice to use **Paint Options** rather than the Paint Code on the Description tab because this will ensure that the proper values are used when the system performs the paint calculations and will comply with Insurance Company requirements.

This job aid shows you how to add Paint information to the Vehicle Options tab on your workfile.

Paint Options

Open the workfile to the **Vehicle** tab.

Click on the **Options** subtab then locate **Paint** on the left-side panel and select it. Finally, select **Two-tone** or **Three-stage Paint** as appropriate under the available Paint Options for this vehicle.

Once selected, you will see them listed on the right-side panel under **Currently Selected Options**.
