Quick Search	The Salvage Coordinator enters a full or partial Claim Reference ID and clicks Search . From the Search Results page, click a Claim Reference ID to open the desired Claim Folder.

Severe	The vehicle has sustained a significant
	amount of damage and may be a parts-
	only vehicle.
Unknown	The severity of the damage is unknown.
