

Photo Timestamp

Timestamp photos with the date and time the photo was captured. To enable, swipe left from the right side of the screen to reveal the Charms bar. On the Charms bar, tap Settings, then General Settings. Tap the Photo Timestamp option to toggle the feature on and off. When enabled, the timestamp will be added to all photos taken from the device.




Date and Time Format

Photo timestamp format is driven off of the Windows date and time settings. To change the format, swipe in from the right to reveal the charms bar and tap "Settings"

Next, tap the "Change PC Settings" link in the lower right-hand corner.



Under PC settings, select the “Time and language” link on the right-hand side.



Under Date and time, select the “Change date and time formats” link
