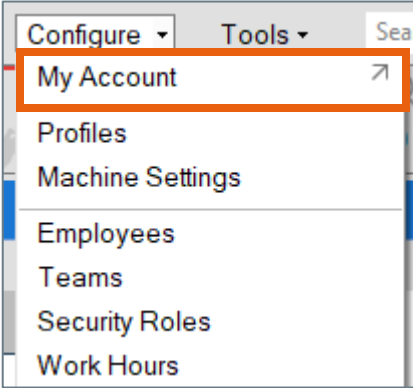
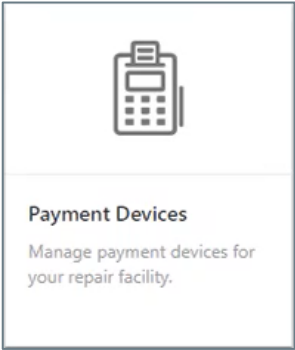
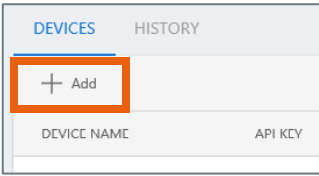

Steps to Register a Payment Device

1	<p>Log into the CCC ONE Desktop application and select Configure > My Account from the menu bar. The cccone.com web page opens.</p> 
2	<p>Click on the Settings link, then click on the Payment Devices tile.</p> 
3	<p>Click +Add.</p>
