

Using Compare to Select Alternative Parts

Overview



Use the Compare feature on the Estimate tab of a CCC[®] Estimating Workfile to compare the cost of repairing a part against the cost of replacing the part with OEM, Aftermarket, Optional OEM, Reconditioned and Recycled parts.

When you select a replacement part option, the system updates the estimate lines and adjusts all hour and dollar amounts. This document explains how to use the Compare feature to select the best part type for the repair/replace.

Procedure

For this example, we assume the administrative and Vehicle information has already been added to the workfile.





Use the following steps to compare parts:

Step	Action
1	<p>In the appropriate workfile, open the Estimate > Lines tab.</p> 
2	<p>Select the MOTOR tab. Use the groups and subgroups to locate the part to add.</p> 
3	<p>Click once to select the part in the database panel.</p>

Step	Action
4	Click Compare on the toolbar. 
5	The Estimate Lines Properties screen displays. The available parts display: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - OEM - Aftermarket - Optional OEM - Reconditioned - Recycled Note: Depending on the availability of parts, only some of these part categories may display.
6	If multiple part types are displayed, click the All Parts drop down menu to filter to only display the desired part type. 
7	Use the Guides > RACED Guide... as needed to view included/not included operations. 
8	Compare the part information and select the appropriate part.
9	Click Add . 
10	If applicable, click Yes or No as appropriate to any refinishing prompts that appear.
11	The selected part is added to the Estimate line.
