

Parts Share – Repair Facility

Overview

Parts share is a client feature associated with CCC ONE that enables Repair Facilities (RFs or Shops) to share estimates with dealers.



When you share estimate using Parts Share ID, the dealer will be able to see all parts that you have selected in an estimate to offer you:

- Competitive pricing
- Requote Part
- Availability of Promotional Pricing
- Order similar cheaper parts available from the dealer DMS system

You can share estimate lines by providing **Parts Share ID**. Dealers will not be able to view estimate lines until you share the unique **Parts Share ID**. A **Parts Share ID** contains six alpha numeric upper and lowercase characters.

Providing Parts Share ID

You can share estimate lines with dealers two ways:

<p>Faxing/Calling: Within a workfile, select File, then click Info to look up the Parts Share ID.
