7 Years & Older Age Group % of Comparison Claim Cnt	Count of comparison claims/appraisals where the vehicle age is seven years or older than the estimate complete date as a percent of the total count of comparison claims. $\frac{(\text{Comparison Claim Cnt where Vehicle Age Group} = 7 \text{ Years \& Older})}{(\text{Comparison Claim Cnt where Vehicle Age Group} = \text{Current Year or Newer, 1-3 Yrs Old, 4-6 Years Old or 7 Years \& Older})}$
Appraiser	<p>The Appraiser is the actual staff appraiser, repair facility, or independent appraisal company that generated estimates or supplements for a given insurance company. The list will display the concatenated appraiser name and appraiser Login ID for staff appraisers. For repair facilities and independent appraiser companies, the list will display the companies' names and will provide the sum total of all individual estimators' work at each company.</p> <p>All data for a single vehicle appraisal will be tied back to the appraiser that generated the original estimate of record. Supplements written by that appraiser for his/her own estimates as well as supplements written by other appraiser(s) for his/her own estimates will be tied back to the appraiser that wrote the original estimate of record.</p> <p>Appraisers will roll up to a claim office (i.e. company hierarchy) based on the claim office for which they worked.</p>

AsgnRetrieve Date	The date the claim assignment was retrieved by the appraiser.
AsgnSent Date	The date the original or first assignment for the claim was sent from the insurance company to the appraiser.
AsgnSent to EstSent Days Avg	Average number of days between the date the original assignment was sent to the date the estimate was sent/uploaded. For Pathways claims, the date the estimate was sent corresponds to the date the estimate was uploaded through EZNet. For non-Pathways claims, the date the estimate was sent corresponds to the date the EMS was attached to the claim folder. $\frac{\text{AsgnSent to EstSent Days}}{\text{AsgnSent to EstSent Cnt}}$
AsgnSent to Last Response Received Days Avg	Average number of days between the date the original assignment was sent to the date the last comparison response was received. $\frac{\text{AsgnSent to Last Response Received Days}}{\text{AsgnSent to Last Response Received Cnt}}$
AsgnSent to Last Settlement Decision Made Days Avg	Average number of days between the date the original assignment was sent to the date the last settlement decision was made. For Pathways claims, the last settlement decision made date corresponds to the date the file was locked and uploaded through EZNet. $\frac{\text{AsgnSent to Last Settlement Decision Made Days}}{\text{AsgnSent to Last Settlement Decision Made Cnt}}$
AsgnSent to Valued Days Avg	Average number of days between the date the original assignment was sent and the date the total loss request was valued. $\frac{\text{AsgnSent to Valued Days}}{\text{AsgnSent to Valued Cnt}}$
Asian % of Comparison Claim Cnt	Count of comparison claims/appraisals where Source is Asian as a percent of the total count of comparison claims. $\frac{(\text{Comparison Claim Cnt where Source} = \text{Asian})}{(\text{Comparison Claim Cnt where Source} = \text{Asian, Domestic or European})}$
Avg Gross Differential Amt	The average absolute dollar difference amount between the gross cost

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	to repair a vehicle and the gross cost to total a vehicle. Gross Differential Amt / Comparison Claim Cnt
Avg Gross Settled Amt	The average total gross dollar amount for claims settled via the settlement "Type" in Pathways or the "Settlement Decision" in Autoverse. If settled as Repairable, this is equivalent to the Repairable Gross Amt. If settled as Total Loss, this is equivalent to the Total Loss Gross Amt. Gross Settled Amt / Comparison Claim Cnt
Avg Net Differential Amt	Average absolute dollar amount between the net cost to repair a vehicle and the net cost to total a vehicle. Net Differential Amt / Comparison Claim Cnt
Avg Net Settled Amt	The average total net dollar amount, accounting for deductible, for claims settled via the settlement "Type" in Pathways or the "Settlement Decision" in Autoverse. If settled as Repairable, this is equivalent to the Repairable Net Amt. If settled as Total Loss, this is equivalent to the Total Loss Net Amt. Net Settled Amt / Comparison Claim Cnt
Avg Repairable Allowance Amt	Average total dollars for appearance allowance on repair option comparison claims/appraisals. Repairable Allowance Amt / Comparison Claim Cnt
Avg Repairable Anticipated Supplement Amt	Average dollars for anticipated supplement changes to the original estimate of record. Repairable Anticipated Supplement Amt / Comparison Claim Cnt
Avg Repairable Betterment Amt	Average total dollars for betterment on repair option comparison claims/appraisals. Repairable Betterment Amt / Comparison Claim Cnt
Avg Repairable Deductible Amt	Average total dollars for deductible on repair option comparison claims/appraisals. Repairable Deductible Amt / Comparison Claim Cnt
Avg Repairable Estimate Amt	Average cost per estimate, including all pretax dollars, prior to adjustments for tax, betterment, allowance, related prior damage, towing, storage and deductible. Repairable Estimate Amt / Comparison Claim Cnt
Avg Repairable Gross Amt	Average total cost to repair a vehicle, including all pretax dollars, anticipated supplement dollar, pre and post tax adjustments, and adjustments for tax, better, allowance, towing, storage, rental and related prior damage. This does not include the deductible. Repairable Gross Amt / Comparison Claim Cnt
Avg Repairable Misc Amt	Average total dollars for miscellaneous charges on repair option comparison claims/appraisals. Repairable Misc Amt / Comparison Claim Cnt
Avg Repairable Net Amt	Average net cost to repair a vehicle, including all pretax dollars, anticipated supplement dollar, pre and post tax adjustments, and adjustments for tax, better, allowance, towing, storage, rental, related prior damage, and deductible. Repairable Net Amt / Comparison Claim Cnt
Avg Repairable PostTax Adj Amt	Average dollar amount for post tax adjustments made on repair option comparison claims/appraisals. Repairable PostTax Adj Amt / Comparison Claim Cnt
Avg Repairable PreTax Adj Amt	Average dollar amount for pre tax adjustments made on repair option comparison claims/appraisals. Repairable PreTax Adj Amt / Comparison Claim Cnt
Avg Repairable Related Prior Damage Amt	Average dollar amount for related prior damage on repair option comparison claims/appraisals. Repairable Related Prior Damage Amt / Comparison Claim Cnt
Avg Repairable Rental Amt	Average dollar amount for rental cost for repair option comparison claims/appraisals. Repairable Rental Amt / Comparison Claim Cnt
Avg Repairable Storage Amt	Average dollars for storage on repair option comparison claims/appraisals. Repairable Storage Amt / Comparison Claim Cnt
Avg Repairable Tax Amt	Average dollars for tax on repair option comparison claims/appraisals. Repairable Tax Amt / Comparison Claim Cnt
Avg Repairable Towing Amt	Average dollars for towing on repair option comparison claims/appraisals.

Avg Total Loss Additional Storage Amt	Average total dollars for additional storage on total loss option comparisons. Total Loss Additional Storage Amt / Comparison Claim Cnt
Avg Total Loss Additional Towing Amt	Average total dollars for additional towing on total loss option comparisons. Total Loss Additional Towing Amt / Comparison Claim Cnt
Avg Total Loss Base Valuation Amt	Average total loss base valuation amount for all comparisons requested. The total loss base valuation amount is a local market value determined by CCC methodology and includes adjustments for condition and refurbishments. Total Loss Base Valuation Amt / Comparison Claim Cnt
Avg Total Loss Deductible Amt	Average total dollars for deductible for total loss option comparisons. Total Loss Deductible Amt / Comparison Claim Cnt
Avg Total Loss Gross Amt	Average total value for a loss vehicle including the base valuation amount, pre and post tax adjustments, tax, towing, additional towing, storage, additional storage, rental, miscellaneous charges, tear down, salvage processing charges, and salvage value. Total Loss Gross Amt / Comparison Claim Cnt
Avg Total Loss Misc Amt	Average total dollars for miscellaneous charges on total loss option comparisons. Total Loss Misc Amt / Comparison Claim Cnt
Avg Total Loss Net Amt	Average net value of a loss vehicle after the deductible is applied. Total Loss Net Amt / Comparison Claim Cnt
Avg Total Loss PostTax Adj Amt	Average total dollars for post tax adjustments on total loss option comparisons. Total Loss PostTax Adj Amt / Comparison Claim Cnt
Avg Total Loss PreTax Adj Amt	Average total dollars for pre tax adjustments on total loss option comparisons. Total Loss PreTax Adj Amt / Comparison Claim Cnt
Avg Total Loss Rental Amt	Average total dollars for rental on total loss option comparisons. Total Loss Rental Amt / Comparison Claim Cnt
Avg Total Loss Salvage High Value Amt	Average dollars for the salvage high value amount received from the salvage vendor. Total Loss Salvage High Value Amt / Comparison Claim Cnt
Avg Total Loss Salvage Low Value Amt	Average dollars for the salvage low value amount received from the salvage vendor for total loss option comparisons. Total Loss Salvage Low Value Amt / Comparison Claim Cnt
Avg Total Loss Salvage Process Amt	Average total dollars for salvage processing fees on total loss option comparisons. Total Loss Salvage Process Amt / Comparison Claim Cnt
Avg Total Loss Salvage Value Amt	Average dollars for the salvage value amount received from the salvage vendor or entered into the comparison. The salvage value amount is an average of the high and low salvage values returned. Total Loss Salvage Value Amt / Comparison Claim Cnt
Avg Total Loss Storage Amt	Average total dollars for storage on total loss option comparisons. Total Loss Storage Amt / Comparison Claim Cnt
Avg Total Loss Tax Amt	Average total dollars for sales tax on total loss option comparisons. Total Loss Tax Amt / Comparison Claim Cnt
Avg Total Loss Tear Down Amt	Average total dollars for tear down on total loss option comparisons. Total Loss Tear Down Amt / Comparison Claim Cnt
Avg Total Loss Towing Amt	Average total dollars for towing on total loss option comparisons. Total Loss Towing Amt / Comparison Claim Cnt
Car % of Comparison Claim Cnt	The count of comparison claims/appraisals where the body category is Car as a percent of the total comparison claim count. (Comparison Claim Cnt where Body Category = Car) / (Comparison Claim Cnt where Type = Car, Motorcycle, Pickup, Utility Vehicle or Van)
Claim Number	The alpha-numeric value assigned as the claim number for the vehicle compared.
Claim Type	Claim Type is an attribute that reflects the type of claim compared. Values include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Light Truck and Car</li> <li>• Motorcycle</li> </ul>
Company	This is a set of attributes that refer to the insuring company for whom

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	Total vs. Repair Comparisons were generated. The prompt window within Intellisphere displays the hierarchy of the company as set up and maintained in CCC's CRM System. This hierarchy includes all locations to which data is tied, as well as all locations at levels above the lowest level locations. Levels within the hierarchy are identified as Level 2 through Level 6, with the Lowest Level Location reflecting the lowest level in a particular branch of a hierarchy to which data is tied.
Comparison Claim Cnt	Count of claims/appraisals that had a Total vs. Repair Comparison run on them resulting in a settlement decision.
Comparison Claim Cnt in Estimate	Count of claims/appraisals that had a Total vs. Repair Comparison run on an estimate (E01).
Comparison Claim Cnt in S01	Count of claims/appraisals that had a Total vs. Repair Comparison run on the first supplement (S01).
Comparison Claim Cnt in S02	Count of claims/appraisals that had a Total vs. Repair Comparison run on the second supplement (S02).
Comparison Claim Cnt in S03+	Count of claims/appraisals that had a Total vs. Repair Comparison run on any third or later supplement (S03+).
Comparison Claim Cnt with Multiple Requests	Count of claims/appraisals that had multiple Total vs. Repair Comparisons run.
Comparison Cnt	Total number of instances a Total vs. Repair Comparison was run resulting in a settlement decision.
Comparison Repairable Claim Cnt	Count of claims/appraisals that had a Total vs. Repair Comparison run resulting in a Repairable settlement decision.
Comparison Requested Date	Date and time a request for salvage values has been made in the Total vs. Repair Comparison product.
Comparison Total Loss Claim Cnt	Count of claims/appraisals that had a Total vs. Repair Comparison run resulting in a Total Loss settlement decision.
Data Source	The estimating platform used to generate the vehicle appraisal: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• CCC Autoverse (designates Pathways data uploaded through the Autoverse portal only)</li> <li>• Pathways (designates Pathways data uploaded through EZNet)</li> <li>• ADP</li> <li>• Mitchell</li> </ul>
Date of Loss	The date of loss for a given claim.
Domestic % of Comparison Claim Cnt	Count of comparison claims/appraisals where Source is Domestic as a percent of the total count of comparison claims. (Comparison Claim Cnt where Source = Domestic) / (Comparison Claim Cnt where Source = Asian, Domestic or European)
EstSent Date	The date and time the original estimate of record was successfully sent. If multiple estimates of record (E01's) are received (reassignment), the EstSent Date will refer to the first E01 received. For non-Pathways claims, this reflects the date and time the EMS is attached to the claim folder. For Pathways claims, this reflects the date and time the estimate is uploaded to EZNet.
File Suffix	File suffix indicates the version (E01, S01, S02, etc) of the file compared.
Gross Differential Amt	The absolute dollar difference between the gross repair amount and the gross total loss amount options. This metric does not account for the deductible amount.
Gross Settled Amt	For comparison claims that have a settlement decision made (i.e. Repairable or Total Loss), this is the gross amount for the claim. If the settlement decision is Total Loss, this is equivalent to the Total Loss Gross Amt. If the settlement decision is Repairable, this is equivalent to the Repairable Gross Amt.
Last Adjuster	An adjuster is the person who typically works in an insurance company and manages the claim on behalf of that company. The last adjuster is the most recent person assigned to manage a claim.
Last AsgnSent Date	The date the latest assignment was sent from the insurance company to an appraiser for a given appraisal/claim.
Last Comparison Requested Date	The date and time of the latest request for salvage values from the Total vs. Repair Comparison product.
Last Response Received Date	The date and time the response (i.e. salvage values) has been received in the Total vs. Repair Comparison.
Last Response Received to Last	The average number of days between the date the last comparison

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Settlement Decision Made Days Avg	response is received and the date the settlement decision was made. $\text{Last Response Received to Last Settlement Decision Made Days} / \text{Last Response Received to Last Settlement Decision Made Cnt}$
Last Settlement Decision Made	This attribute reflects whether the loss vehicle compared is settled as a repairable or total loss vehicle. For comparisons run through Pathways, this is indicated using the Settlement Type field. For comparisons run through Autoverse, this is indicated using the Settlement Option field.
Last Settlement Decision Made Date	The date and time the last settlement decision was made.
Light Truck % of Comparison Claim Cnt	The count of comparison claims/appraisals where the body category is Truck as a percent of the total comparison claim cnt. $(\text{Comparison Claim Cnt where Body Category} = \text{Truck}) / (\text{Comparison Claim Cnt where Type} = \text{Car, Motorcycle, Pickup, Utility Vehicle or Van})$
Loss Category	Loss Category is the type of coverage for a particular claim. Valid loss categories include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Collision</li> <li>• Comprehensive</li> <li>• Liability</li> <li>• Other</li> <li>• Unknown</li> </ul>
LossRpt Date	The date the loss was reported to the insurance company for a given claim.
Loss to LossRpt Days Avg	The average number of days between the date of loss and the date the loss was reported. $\text{Loss to LossRpt Days} / \text{Loss to LossRpt Cnt}$
LossRpt to Last Settlement Decision Made Avg	The average number of days between the date the loss was reported and the date the last settlement decision was made. $\text{LossRpt to Last Settlement Decision Made Days} / \text{LossRpt to Last Settlement Decision Made Cnt}$
Make	Vehicle make is the make as decoded from the VIN.
Model	The vehicle model name as specified in the vehicle appraisal.
Net Differential Amt	The absolute difference between the net total loss amount and net repairable amount options.
Net Settled Amt	For comparisons with a settlement decision (i.e. Repairable or Total Loss), this is the net amount of the claim accounting for the deductible amount.
Non-Driveable % of Comparison Claim Cnt	The count of claims/appraisals where the vehicle is not driveable as a percent of the total comparison claim cnt. $(\text{Comparison Claim Cnt where Vehicle Driveable Flag} = \text{Non-Driveable}) / (\text{Comparison Claim Cnt where Vehicle Driveable Flag} = \text{Driveable or Non-Driveable})$
Period	<p>The "Period" set of attributes include years, quarters, and months:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The lowest period resolution that information will be displayed is at a monthly resolution. Data is updated as soon as information for that month is loaded into the summary tables at the close of each week. Once data is received in a weekly load for the following month, Current Month will advance to next month.</li> <li>• Updates to the management information are made weekly. CCC's Data Warehouse production cycle runs on the weekend. Once that production cycle is complete, all summary tables for Intellisphere will be updated so you can access the new data by Monday.</li> </ul> <p>The date the last comparison response is received is used to determine the month into which the data for that salvage assignment should fall.</p>
Repairable Allowance Amt	Total dollars for allowance.
Repairable Anticipated Supplement Amt	Total dollars for the anticipated supplement. If enabled for the comparison product, this amount is initially populated with an amount determined by CCC methodology, but may be edited by the requestor.
Repairable Betterment Amt	Total dollars for betterment.
Repairable Cnt where Repairable Cost < Total Loss Cost	A count of comparison claims where the Settlement Decision Made is Repairable and the Repairable Net Amt is less than the Total Loss Net Amt

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Repairable Cnt where Total Loss Cost < Repairable Cost	A count of comparison claims where the Settlement Decision Made is Repairable and the Total Loss Net Amt is less than the Repairable Net Amt
Repairable Deductible Amt	Total dollars for deductible.
Repairable Estimate Amt	This is the sum of PreTax Amt for all comparison claims/appraisals that are estimates (file suffix = E01) at the time the comparison was requested.
Repairable Gross Amt	The total cost to repair a vehicle accounting for the pretax estimate dollars, any anticipated supplement amount, pre and post tax adjustments, tax, allowance, towing, storage, related prior damage, miscellaneous costs, and betterment.
Repairable Misc Amt	Total dollars for miscellaneous charges as entered by the requestor in the comparison product.
Repairable Net Amt	The net cost of repairs after the deductible has been applied. $\text{Repairable Gross Amt} - \text{Repairable Deductible Amt}$
Repairable PostTax Adj Amt	Adjustments made to the comparison claim/appraisal after sales tax is applied.
Repairable PreTax Adj Amt	Adjustments made to the comparison claim/appraisal before sales tax is applied. Typical adjustments made may be an overall pretax adjustment or a discount on a labor rate. These adjustments are carried over from the Rates tab (Discount View) in the Pathways workfile.
Repairable Related Prior Damage Amt	Total dollars for related prior damage.
Repairable Rental Amt	Total dollars for rental.
Repairable Storage Amt	Total dollars for storage.
Repairable Tax Amt	The total dollar amount for taxes on completed estimates and supplements.
Repairable Towing Amt	Total dollars for towing. Towing is sourced from the tow worksheet within Pathways or from within the estimate EMS if a non-Pathways comparison.
Repairable/Total Loss Ratio	The ratio of the overall repairable net dollar amount to the overall total loss net dollar amount. $\text{Repairable Net Amt} / \text{Total Loss Net Amt}$
Repairable/Total Loss Ratio for flagged Repairables	The ratio of the overall repairable net dollar amount to the overall total loss net dollar amount where the last settlement decision is Repairable. $(\text{Repairable Net Amt} / \text{Total Loss Net Amt}) \text{ where Last Settlement Decision Flag} = \text{Repairable}$
Repairable/Total Loss Ratio for flagged Total Losses	The ratio of the overall repairable net dollar amount to the overall total loss net dollar amount where the last settlement decision is Total Loss. $(\text{Repairable Net Amt} / \text{Total Loss Net Amt}) \text{ where Last Settlement Decision Flag} = \text{Total Loss}$
Response Received Date	Date and time the response (salvage values) was received by the comparison.
Salvage Value Requestor	The individual who ran a comparison for a given loss vehicle. The individual requesting a comparison has the option to run the comparison from Pathways or from within Autoverse.  The list name will display the concatenated requestor name and requestor ID. If the request is made from Pathways, the requestor ID is equivalent to the Pathways login ID. If the request is made from within Autoverse, the requestor ID is equivalent to the portal login ID.  All comparison data will be tied back to the individual requesting the salvage value.
Salvage Vendor Damage Description	The damage description returned from the salvage vendor.
SUV % of Comparison Claim Cnt	The count of comparison claims/appraisals where the vehicle type is SUV as a percent of the total comparison claim count. $(\text{Comparison Claim Cnt where Type} = \text{Utility Vehicle}) / (\text{Comparison Claim Cnt where Type} = \text{Car, Motorcycle, Pickup, Utility Vehicle or Van})$
Total Loss Additional Storage Amt	Total dollars for additional storage.

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Total Loss Additional Towing Amt	Total dollars for additional towing.
Total Loss Base Valuation Amt	The local market base valuation amount as determined by CCC methodology plus any condition adjustment or refurbishment adjustment amount.
Total Loss Cnt where Repairable Cost < Total Loss Cost	A count of comparison claims where the Settlement Decision Made is Total Loss and the Repairable Net Amt is less than the Total Loss Net Amt
Total Loss Cnt where Total Loss Cost < Repairable Cost	A count of comparison claims where the Settlement Decision Made is Total Loss and the Total Loss Net Amt is less than the Repairable Net Amt
Total Loss Deductible Amt	Total dollars for deductible.
Total Loss Gross Amt	This is the base valuation amount plus pre and post tax adjustments, tax, towing, additional towing, storage, additional storage, rental, miscellaneous charges, tear down, salvage processing charges, and salvage value.
Total Loss Misc Amt	Total dollars for miscellaneous charges.
Total Loss Net Amt	The net cost to total a vehicle after the deductible has been applied.
Total Loss PostTax Adj Amt	Adjustments made to the value of the vehicle after Sales Tax is applied. These are generally not items on the vehicle itself, but fees associated with the settlement process. A typical PostTax item includes DMV fees (for title transfer).
Total Loss PreTax Adj Amt	Adjustments made to the value of the vehicle before Sales Tax is applied. Typical PreTax Adjustments are deductions for prior damage, dealer preparation fees mandated by many states, or after-factory add-on items added to the car such as alarm systems or aftermarket stereo systems.
Total Loss Rental Amt	Total dollars for rental.
Total Loss Salvage High Value Amt	The total dollars for all high salvage value amounts received from the salvage vendor.
Total Loss Salvage Low Value Amt	The total dollars for all low salvage value amounts received from the salvage vendor.
Total Loss Salvage Process Amt	Total dollars for salvage processing charges.
Total Loss Salvage Value Amt	The total dollars for all the average salvage value amounts received from the salvage vendor or entered in the comparison as the expected salvage value amount. The salvage value amount received by the salvage vendor is an average of the high and low salvage value amounts.
Total Loss Storage Amt	Total dollars for storage. Storage is sourced from the tow worksheet within Pathways or from within the estimate EMS if a non-Pathways comparison.
Total Loss Tax Amt	The total dollar amount for taxes on completed estimates and supplements.
Total Loss Tear Down Amt	Total dollars for tear down charges.
Total Loss Towing Amt	Total dollars for towing. Towing is sourced from the tow worksheet within Pathways or from within the estimate EMS if a non-Pathways comparison.
Total of All Salvage Value Requestors	A drillable attribute that can be included on a report to support drilling to the individual salvage value requestor once the report results have been returned.
Valuation Date	The date the valuation was generated by CCC.
Valuation Request Number	The number CCC assigns to each valuation completed to uniquely identify each valuation.
Valued to Comparison Requested Days Avg	The average number of days from the valuation date to the date the comparison was requested.
